

READ MICAH 6:8

Today's verse makes it pretty clear what God expects of those who follow Him. And it's not saying He expects us to be perfect.

What God wants for us, what He expects of us, is pretty simple. We are called to act with justice—to treat others fairly. To love mercy—to choose kindness always. And to live humbly. God wants you to work hard at putting others first. He wants you to pay attention to the people around you and see how you can help.
